- > How will you investigate this case? 4
- > Write differential diagnosis of membrane over the tonsil 4

2. A 60 year old male, who is chain smoker, presented in OPD with hoarseness of voice for last 6 months. he is complaining of dyspnea for last 2 weeks. On IDL a fleshy mass was seen on right vocal cord.

- > What is the most probable diagnosis? 2
- > How will you investigate this case? 4
- > Enumerate the causes of stridor 4

Congenital = laryngeal web, vocal cord  
Acquired = Trauma, Foreign body, Neoplasia, Allergy

3. A 20 year male presented in emergency with complaint of dyspnea, sore throat, fever and odynophagia for last 4 days. he was having history of dental extraction 2 days back. on examination there was tenderness and hard swelling of the submental and submandibular region.

- > What is the most probable diagnosis? 2
- > How will you treat this case? 4
- > Enumerate the causative micro-organism of this disease 4

4. A 4 year boy presented in ENT emergency with history of coin ingestion and dysphagia for last 2 hours.

- > How will you investigate this case 2
- > What complications could develop on removing it? 2
- > Enumerate the constrictions of oesophagus 2
