2. A 60-year P1, menopausal for 8 years, presented with Postmenopausal bleeding. Her BMI is 30kg/m² and suffers from type 2 D.M. On examination uterus is bulky and scan shows endometrial thickness of 12mm.
 - a. What is the differential diagnosis? 1
 - b. How will you confirm the diagnosis? 0.5
 - c. How will you manage her? 1.5

3. A 32-year G3P2 presents after 6 weeks of amenorrhea in OPD. Her pregnancy test is positive. Her B.P is 100/60mmHg, pulse is 88/min. on USG no intrauterine gestational sac or adnexal mass seen.
