- (a) What is your diagnosis? (b) What is the drug of choice in this case? (c) Enumerate two signs of toxicity of this drug. (d) How will you manage this patient? (3)

Ques. 3. A 37 year old para 4 presented in the labour ward with history of delivery at home 3 days back, now having heavy vaginal bleeding since morning:

- (a) What is the diagnosis? (b) What is the common cause for this condition? (c) How will you manage her? (3)

Ques. 4. A G3P2 + 0 at 36 weeks of gestation presented in outpatient department for antenatal checkup. With ultrasound report showing breech presentation:

- (a) What is ECV and at what gestation it should be done? (b) Write contraindications of ECV? (c) What are the risks of ECV? (3)

Ques. 5. A G4P0 + 3 at 26 weeks of pregnancy, she conceived with IVF, on examination her fundal height is 30cm and multiple fetal parts are palpable. On USG there is twin pregnancy.

- (a) What fetal and maternal antenatal complications can occur in this pregnancy? (b) How to determine chorionicity in twin pregnancy? (3)

Ques. 6. A 30 year old G3P2 + 0 presented in labour room at 39 weeks with history of regular uterine contractions. Fetal heart rate is 140 per minute, she is 7cm for last three hours:

- (a) What is the diagnosis of this lady? (b) What factors are responsible for this abnormality? (c) How will you manage the patient? (3)

Ques. 7. A para 4 delivered at home, a full term male baby 2 days ago, she presents with chills, rigors and temperature 101 degree Fahrenheit with foul smelling lochia:

- (a) Define puerperal pyrexia? (b) What are the commonly associated organisms? (c) Name some risk factors for puerperal infection? (3)
