Q5: A 31 years old rheumatoid female presented in eye OPD with pain and redness in her right eye. On examination there was focal nodular swelling at sclera that didn't vanish with phenylethifrine eye drops. What is your diagnosis? How you will treat this patient?

Q6: A 54 years old diabetic + steroid patient presented with gradual progressive decreased vision in his both eyes that is worse in sun light. What is your diagnosis? How you will manage this case.
