✓ Q-No: 1 A 21 years old male presents with right lower quadrant pain for the last four days with nausea and vomiting. He is also febrile with pulse rate of 110/min. On examination there is a tender 6x 8cm mass palpable in the right lower quadrant.

✓ Q-No: 2. A 35-year female presents in the OPD with complain of dysphagia for the liquids since 2 months. There is a history of some weight loss.

- a. What is the probable diagnosis? 1
- b. How will you manage this case? 4

✓ Q-No: 3 A 45-year male presents in the A&E with sudden severe upper abdominal pain radiating to the back associated with vomiting. On examination he is anxious, tachypnic with pulse=120/min, B.P= 100/60 mm of Hg. His abdomen is distended with marked tenderness in the upper half of abdomen.

- a. What is the probable diagnosis? 1
- b. How will you manage this case? 4

✓ Q-No: 4 A 50-year shop keeper presents in the A&E with complaints of absolute constipation, abdominal distension and colicky abdominal pain. There is a H/O appendectomy two year ago. On examination his pulse is 100/min, temp=98 F, abdomen is distended with exaggerated bowel sound.

- a. What is the diagnosis? 1
- b. How will you manage this case? 4

✓ Q-No: 5 A 32year female presents in the OPD with complaints of pain in right flank since one month. On USG 9mm stone in the upper calyx of right kidney.

- a. How will you further investigate this patient? 2
- b. Enlist treatment options. 3



✓ Q-No: 6 A 2-year old boy presents with pain in the left hip joint. He is reluctant to move his left hip. There is a history of intermittent high grade fever. On X-ray there is widening of joint space.

✓ Q-No: 7 A 70-year male presents in the A&E with acute urinary retention for 12 hours. On examination bladder is palpable, patient is vitally stable;

✓ Q-No: 9 A 25-year female presents in the OPD with complaints of painless lump in the right breast since 20days. There is no history of fever. Lump is freely mobile.

✓ Q-No: 10 A 30-year motorcyclist was brought to the hospital after a RTA sustained head injury. There is a history of brief period of unconsciousness. On examination his GCS is 12, pinpoint pupil of right side. His CT scan shows extradural hematoma in the left parietal region.

✓ Q-No: 11 A 50 year female presents in the OPD with complaints of swelling in front of the neck for the last 12-years. Recently she noticed weight loss and diarrhea with palpitation and preference-for cold weather. On examination her pulse is 110/ min, sweating and tremors of hand with nodular goiter.
