


# STRUCTURE AND FUNCTIONS OF SKIN

## Anatomy of skin


Epidermis

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## **Epidermis**

#### 1.Stratum basale

- Tall columnar cells with large nuclei
- Scattered in between are Melanocytes

#### 2.Stratum Spinosum (prickle cell layer)

- Several polygonal squamous cells
- Attached to each other by intercellular bridges (prickles)

#### 3.St.Granulosum


Transversely lying cells with keratohyaline granules


#### 4.St. lucidum

· Clear zone found in palms and soles

#### 5.St.Corneum

Several rows of anucleated cornified cells
